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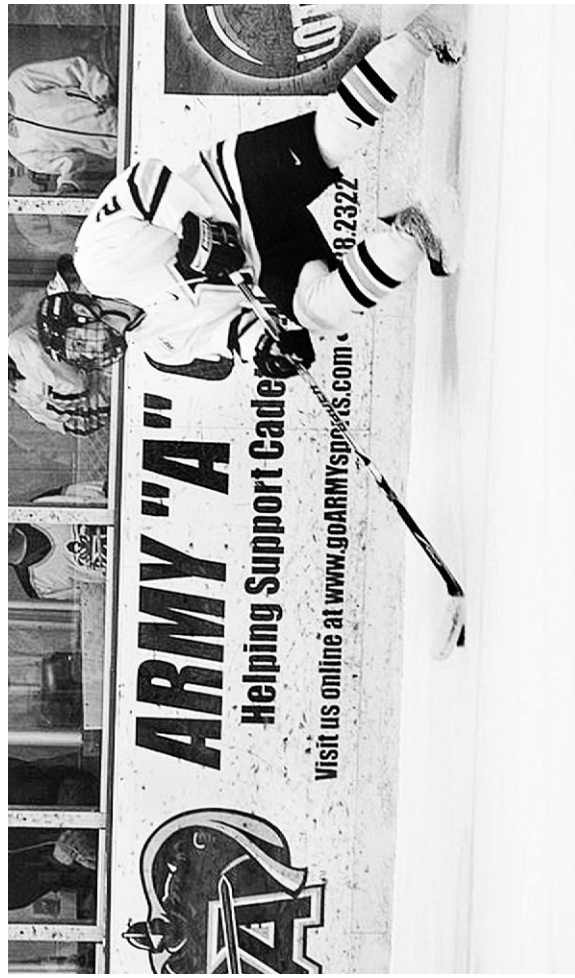

# The Army Hockey Camp

Each camper will receive three hours of ice daily, two hours of fundamental skills and power skating in the morning and an hour scrimmage game in the evening. Off-ice activities include a chalk talk, videos, organized games and swimming.

## Camp Facilities

Experience United States Military Academy atmosphere at historic and beautiful West Point. Campers will have use of Army's new hockey arena, as well as other facilities that the cadets use during the year. These include: Outdoor swimming, gymnasium and football fields. The tuition cost of **\$650.00** boarding includes all meals, housing at the cadet barracks, use of all facilities, as well as a hockey jersey and team picture. **Beds** and **cots** are used.

**NOTE:** Anyone attending camp for more than one week must be picked up on Friday and return on Sunday. The barracks close down and there are no other sleeping accommodations available to us for Friday and Saturday evenings.

## Medical Facilities

A certified trainer will be present at all times during practice sessions and scrimmages. A local physician will be on call and Keller Army Hospital, located at West Point, is available for all emergencies.

## Age Groups

Boys 8 to 16 years of age are eligible to attend. No camper can be a high school graduate by NCAA Rules. All participants will be divided into groups based on age, size, experience and ability.

## Off-Ice Directors

## Application Deadline

Applications will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis until the camp is fully enrolled. Camps at West Point are very popular and fill early. Don't wait too long to mail your application. If your application is late, your name will be placed on a waiting list.

## Deposit

A deposit of **\$400.00** is required with each application. If attending more than one week, a deposit of **\$400.00** for **each week is required**. There is no refund after the application is accepted.

## Registration Time

Check-in times will be on Sunday afternoon between 2:00 P.M. and 3:00 P.M. Each camp will notify their campers of the exact times.

## Check-Out

Parents are invited to the Friday early morning game to observe their sons. Check-out will occur following the Friday game at the hockey rink.

## Meals

The first meal is on Sunday evening and the last is breakfast on Friday morning. All meals are mandatory, and are served at Eisenhower Hall and the hockey rink.

## Ice Hockey Equipment

All campers must provide all their **own** equipment. No roller hockey equipment will be permitted.

## Location & Transportation

The United States Military Academy at West Point is located in the heart of the picturesque Hudson Valley area. The Academy is easily accessible from Long Island via the Palisades Parkway; from Upstate New York via the New York State Thruway; from Philadelphia, New Jersey and Maryland via the New Jersey Turnpike and Garden State Parkway and from New England via Interstate 84.

## Camp Store

A bank will be established for all campers to deposit cash for expenses. They will be debited for any purchases during camp. Whatever cash is remaining at check-out will be returned to each camper in their envelope!

## Day Campers

There will be a limited number of spaces for day campers during *each session*. Day campers will participate in all activities and eat all their meals with their groups. They will be picked up at the rink after their last ice session in the evening. The fee for day campers is **\$550.00**. A **\$400.00** deposit is required when sending in the camp application.

## Roommates

A limit of three roommates per camper can be requested. Once received and processed they cannot be changed.

## Health Forms

All health forms must be turned in 3 weeks prior to the 1st day of camp. Please complete each section, (i.e. insurance info, doctor's name and address, signatures). If your child will be bringing prescribed medication, you must also complete a medication administration form complete with a physician's signature. All health forms can be downloaded from the website.

## Prepayment Procedure

**We are requesting that all campers be prepaid three weeks prior to their camp session.**

Like last year, we will have an express line for all prepayment customers who have all their paperwork in (i.e., medical waiver form, payment in full for camp registration). On the express line we will have an envelope for each customer consisting of what group they are in, room assignment, ice and game times. This will allow for an easier method of making lines shorter and being more efficient.
